

On the Front Lines with Health Fairs and Family Festivals

Willy has a heart for evangelism, especially reaching out to the needy and hurting in the inner-city of Rochester. He touches his community by building relationships. He is a networker and resource person for helping churches touch their neighborhoods in relevant and dynamic ways. He is a sought-after leader who shares his passion, insight, and experience with other churches and ministries who desire to change their communities through the love of Jesus expressed in practical ways.



As founder of Adonai Community Services and Adonai Community Fellowship, and 2008 graduate of Northeastern Seminary, Rev. Wilfredo “Willy” Irizarry’s leadership and influence have been widely felt in Rochester and beyond. The Rochester Family Fun Festival and Health Fair at the North Street Recreation Center drew over 5,000 people last year. This year the hope is to reach up to 10,000 people with the first 1,000 families in attendance receiving a free bag of groceries.

Pastor Willy is leading the effort to partner with churches, community agencies, businesses, and others in Fort Myers, Florida to hold a Family Fun Festival and Health Fair at the Harborside Events Center and Centennial Park in the hopes of drawing 30,000 people. The first 5,000 will receive a free bag of groceries. Festivals are also being planned in San Antonio, Texas and Nashville, Tennessee. Income above the cost of running the events is used to fund grants for inner-city ministries.
