

MASTERS SCHOLARSHIPS AND COST SHEET

Seminary Granted Scholarships

Semester One Scholarship: Available to degree seeking students who demonstrate a commitment to successfully transition to student life by taking advantage of pre-orientation tools provided by the Seminary. Students receive this one-time award of \$1,000 in their first semester. Students must be registered for at least 9 credit hours.

Need-based Scholarship: Available to students whose Estimated Family Contribution (EFC), as determined on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), falls between \$0 and \$16,000. Students who qualify will receive \$700 per semester. To retain scholarship, the student must complete a FAFSA and qualify annually. Students must be registered for at least 9 credit hours.

Academic Scholarship: Available to students in recognition of academic excellence: \$1,000 annually for students whose GPA for their last degree earned was a 3.5 to 3.79; \$2,000 annually for students whose GPA for their last degree earned was a 3.8 to 4.0. To be considered for this scholarship you must be accepted and deposited by June 15 (for fall semester) or November 15 (for spring semester) and must be a matriculated, degree-seeking student. Students must be registered for at least 9 credit hours.

Accentuate Relevance Distinction Scholarship: Describes the Seminary's unwavering commitment to biblical and historic Christianity and our unshakeable resolve to respond to the actual contemporary needs of the church and world. Awarded to seminarians who are pursuing a fresh view of ministry in the 21st century and are attentive to the multiplicity of ministry contexts in today's world.

Embody Diversity Distinction Scholarship: The Seminary is a community of learners committed to increasingly reflecting the global breadth of Christ's kingdom in racial, ethnic, gender, and ecclesial diversity. Awarded to seminarians who are pursuing experiential and cross-cultural learning opportunities including global and multi-ethnic ministry contexts.
