

MASTERS GUIDELINES FOR AUTOBIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

Applicants must present evidence of their readiness for graduate studies in theology. Seminary applicants must meet a variety of admissions criteria including, but not limited to, quality of character, spiritual maturity, and vocational vision for the church and/or society. This confidential autobiographical statement enables you to communicate personally with the committee. The essay-format autobiographical statement is to be 1,000-1,500 words, typewritten in 12-point font and double spaced. Organize your statement per the following three sections, using the headings below as subtitles. Spiritual Pilgrimage

Describe how you came to know Christ, the factors of influence, and the steps in the process.

Christian Service

What has influenced your calling to Christian service? How have your primary relationships or personal journey influenced this call to service?

Career Goals and Plans

Outline the past and current status of your involvement in ministry and the role seminary plays in your career plans?
