Northeastern Seminary Scholarship:

10% reduction in tuition

This scholarship is awarded annually and is based on the financial need of the student as determined by Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) eligibility. The FAFSA can be completed online at studentaid.gov. Please indicate the Seminary's school code of G34194. The FAFSA must be updated each academic year.

Northeastern Seminary Presidential Scholarship:

25% reduction in tuition

This scholarship is awarded annually and is based on evidence of academic strength in previous work and potential for contribution to ministry development. Recipients must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 to retain the scholarship. If a student qualifies for more than one level of scholarship, the single highest level will be awarded.
